Energy Conservation

TAMU has improved energy efficiency by 29.2% from FY02 - FY08, measured in mBtu* consumption per gross square foot (GSF). This improvement in energy efficiency has cost avoided \$71.4 million over this six-year period, and also resulted in a 21.5% reduction of carbon dioxide emissions per GSF due to reduced natural gas and electricity consumption during the same period of time.
