
MEMORANDUM

Subject: Children's Center

At the October 31, 2005 meeting of the Campus Facilities Planning Committee, the committee members voted unanimously to recommend approval of the proposed addition to the Children's Center. The approximately 2,800 square foot addition will include an auditorium/multipurpose facility. As presented, the addition is needed to support current enrollment levels, which are intended to remain static. The estimated cost of the project was estimated at approximately \$600,000. Funding will be provided by the Division of Student Affairs.
