SUBJECT: Agriculture Land Use Proposal

At its September 21, 2006 meeting, the Council on Built Environment approved an Agriculture Program land use plan (attached) for land north of F&B Road. The land will be known as the Agricultural and Environmental Life Sciences Center and will be used by faculty and students for research and education. The area will also include 15 acres for use by the Physical Plant. Once fully utilized, the area will free up approximately 200,000 square feet of space and 255 acres of land on the main and west campus for the university to use in other ways.

Each facility built on these sites will need prior approval by CBE and the President. Also, until the area is developed, if it is determined that there is a higher need for the land, the Agriculture Program will be consulted on alternate use.

Since development of the land is dependent on donor funding, contingent on your approval, CBE will Dr. Ed Davis, co-chair of the Development Strategy Group, to make him aware of this donor opportunity. Also, contingent upon your approval, CBE will inform Texas A&M University System representatives so they are also aware of this land use decision.
