Subject: Reed Arena Addition

At a special meeting of the Campus Facilities Planning Committee, held yesterday, May 8, 2006, the committee members voted to recommend that the proposed addition to Reed Arena proceed as presented. The addition will be used by the men's and women's basketball teams and will include practice gymnasias, training areas, coaches' offices and other related spaces. Although the final site plan is pending it is conceived that the project will be approximately 37,000 gross square feet in size and is estimated to cost approximately \$15 million. Funding will be provided by the Athletic Department. Additional detail is available in the attached comments from the CFPC-technical subcommittee.
