SUBJECT: Storage Facility

At its August 30, 2006 meeting, the Council on Built Environment (CBE) approved in concept your preproposal to construct a 1,200 square foot metal facility near the Schmidt House on F&B Road for use as a storage facility by Student Government and Student Activities.

Approval of your preproposal means that you can take the concept to the Campus Facilities Planning Committee (CFPC) for further review, discussion and recommended action by the CBE. However, CBE approval of the preproposal does not mean that approval has been given for any funding for the project, priority of construction or renovation, donor approach, or other specific considerations.

The Council understands that you may be able to use storage space at the Food Services Commissary and, if so, the new facility would not be needed. However, if it is determined that the Commissary does not meet your needs and you would like to pursue construction of the facility, please contact Mr. James Massey to add this item to the next CFPC agenda.
