SUBJECT: Recommendation from the Council on Built Environment

At its December 20, 2006 meeting, the Council on Built Environment reviewed the attached recommendation from the Campus Facilities Planning Committee regarding a proposed Nautical Archaeology Conservation Lab Building to be located on the Riverside Campus.

The S.C. Johnson Company approached the Department of Anthropology about conserving the remains of an airplane once owned by the company's founder. The company has agreed to pay for the construction of the building, which would belong to the University once completed, and the department will pay for the site work. Since the facility needs to be completed by September, 2007, the department will ensure that the cost of the building does not exceed \$1 million, so it will not require Board of Regents or Coordinating Board approval.

The initial operations in this building will be auxiliary in nature. Thus, utilities and operations costs will be billed to the unit.

The Council approves of this project and recommends approval by the President.
