

**Council Chairs Meeting
September 6, 2006**

- **Council on the Built Environment**
 - Units are beginning their moves into the GSC this week.
 - The Council approved allowing Human Resources to use some of the first floor shelled space in the GSC for their Employee Education Center
 - CBE has approved in concept residence halls being located on the north side of campus, near parking areas 77 and 30, near the Davis-Gary Hall. New residence halls would be operation before the older residences are demolished. Another site requested by Residence Life, on west campus, has been sent to APC members for their comments.
 - CBE has approved in concept a storage facility for Student Government and Student Affairs use, to be located off F&B Road. The new facility may not be needed, however, if it is determined that storage space at the Food Services Commissary will meet their needs.
 - Since no other suggested uses for Cain Hall were submitted, “A” wing and the dining room will be used by the division of student affairs to house Student Counseling Service and Residence Life. The CBE will be considering which units will move into the space vacated by these two units.
 - Dean Murano has proposed a land use plan for land north of F&B Road. CBE has requested comments from APC.
 - The FY07 Deferred Maintenance list has been sent to President Gates for his approval.
 - The Campus Master Planners will be back on campus next week to meet with University representatives to discuss district plans for the campus.

- **Education Council**
 - Cook will send the final report on the Murano Task Force recommendations to Prior within the next week.

- **Finance Council**
 - The Finance Council fall meeting schedule will begin later this month.

- **Research Council**
 - The Research Council has not met since the last Council Chairs meeting.

- **General Discussion**
 - Council Chairs discussed the overall Council process and its relationship to the creation of task forces and standing committees.
