EMERGENCY?



CALL 911

- Stay calm.
- Provide your location.
- •Stay on the line.
- Answer all questions.
- Follow all directions.

Can't call? Text 911.

ACTIVE THREAT



RUN/AVOID when in danger.

- Attempt to evacuate.
- · Leave belongings behind.
- Help others if you can.
- Call 911 when you are safe.



HIDE/DENY if you can't run.

- · Lock/block the door.
- · Silence phones.
- Remain quiet.
- Hide behind objects.



FIGHT/DEFEND if you must.

- Attempt to incapacitate the attacker.
- Act aggressively.
- Commit to your actions.

FIRE

In a fire or if the fire alarm sounds:

- Evacuate the area.
- Use the nearest exit.
- Do not use elevators.



- Go to your designated gathering area.
- Do not reenter the building until authorized personnel give the all clear.
- Call 911 if you need help evacuating.

MEDICAL EMERGENCY



Call 911 if the person:

- Can't breathe
- Is unresponsive
- Has chest pain
- Has uncontrolled bleeding

If necessary, and if you are trained:

- Give basic first aid
- Provide CPR
- Utilize AED
